Introduction

This Sunday, we continued our study through the book of Mark as we covered Mark 6:1-13, looking Jesus being rejected and followed.

Read: Mark 6:1-6

Jesus is speaking in the synagogue and the people are questioning Jesus based on his family and his background.

These people have put Jesus in a box, based on their understanding and preconceived notions of who he was. If we're being honest, what boxes have we put Jesus in? When have we limited Jesus' power with our unbelief?

True wisdom is a byproduct of walking in close proximity with God. Jesus didn't just learn by something he did, he learned by being in close proximity with God. What does it look like for us to live our lives in close proximity with God?

Read: Mark 6:7-13

Jesus sends out the twelve, instructing them on what they need to do and what they need to leave behind.

The first thing we notice is that Jesus sends them out in teams. Evangelism is a group effort. Can you think of a time when you were trying to reach somebody for Christ? Did you do this on your own or was it a group effort and how did that affect the outcome?

Their faith was unshakeable. Jesus instructs them not to bring money, clothes, or food (the essentials). They had to trust in God to provide for their needs. Is there a time in your life when you didn't know how things would work out and you had to fully rely on God for your needs?

Jesus called the disciples to do something risky. What "risky endeavor" has God laid on your heart that he may be calling you to do?

What do you need to give up for God? Is there something in your life that makes you feel safe and secure that you feel God calling you to give up for him?

Take some time in prayer to pray for those that shared about what God has called them to do or to give up. Pray for strength and wisdom in following God's calling.
